Sandy Springs: The Prado shopping center is getting a face-lift over the next 18 months, but Sembler, the company that owns the center, said the restaurants will remain open during that time. Nick Gold, a spokesman for the center, said the company will do everything it can to help Kobe Steaks, Joli-Kobe Cafe and Bakery, Frankie's Sports Grill and 5 Seasons Brewery stay open during the overhaul, which includes an expansion to nearby properties and a new exterior for the 34-year-old center.
