## "Here For The Beer": Czech Out This Vacation Package for Beer Lovers

*Second Czech Beer Festival to take place from May 22 - 31*

March 4, 2009 - Atlanta, Georgia - Ready for a party? Why not hop on over to Prague, the capital of the Czech Republic, to take part in this year's Second Czech Beer Festival! It will be held for ten days (from May 22 until May 31, 2009) and features at least fifty different top quality Czech beer brands, as well as authentic Czech cuisine prepared by chefs of famous local restaurants such as Svejks Restaurant and Kolkovna. Eight large tents will be set up to accommodate a total of at least 10,000 visitors, and each tent will have its own stage and live entertainment. If you want to celebrate some of the world's best beer at this Festival, or just sample Czech beers on your own at another time, you may be interested in the hotel and air transportation combined in this unique vacation package from Austrian Airlines. "Here For The Beer" was specifically created for individual travelers who want to discover where some of the best beer in the world was first brewed - and where it is still being made according to centuries-old traditions and recipes.

Starting at \$1,269 per person, double occupancy, the "Here For The Beer" vacation package includes roundtrip economy class air transportation on Austrian Air between either New York (JFK) or Washington, DC (IAD) and Prague, three (3) nights hotel accommodation in the superior tourist class Hotel U Tri Korunek, daily buffet breakfast, hotel service charges and hotel taxes. In addition, a 3-hour walking tour in the evening including three beers plus dinner, a full-day Pilsen and Pilsner Urquell Brewery Tour plus lunch in the Spilka Beer Restaurant, as well as a three-course dinner at the traditional Prague restaurant Pivovarsky dum are part of the experience. The package is valid for travel between April 1 - October 25, 2009, and the rate for travel during the peak summer months (between June 1 - August 30) is \$1,549 per person.

In addition to this three-night "Here For The Beer" package, a variety of other vacation packages (called City Steals and Combo City Steals) are offered for travel to Europe by Austrian Air Vacation Center; check [www.austrianair-vacations.com](http://www.austrianair-vacations.com). Single supplements, upgrades, additional combinations and extensions are available upon request.

All packages must be paid in full within 7 days after reservations are confirmed, and no later than 14 days prior to departure. Once confirmed, the packages are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be changed. All packages will be booked on Austrian Airlines in economy class and are subject to schedule and space availability. The minimum stay is 3 nights or one Saturday overnight, and the maximum stay in Europe is 30 days. Package prices include fuel surcharges but do not include US Customs / INS / Aphis fees / International Transportation Tax / Passenger Facility Charges / Civil Aviation Security Fee / domestic and foreign Security and Airport Charges of approximately USD \$155 per passenger, depending on the itinerary. Additional taxes and fees may be collected by foreign governments. All taxes / fees / surcharges are subject to change and exchange rate fluctuations and may vary on the day of booking.
