Datebook: Events in Melbourne, Prague and Nashville

PRAGUE

The Czech Beer Festival (May 22 to 31) will feature at least 50 different beers and food prepared by local chefs. Events will take place under eight large tents, each of which will be equipped with its own stage for live entertainment (www.cesky pivnifestival.cz/en). Admission is free, while food, drinks and merchandise can be purchased with the festival currency, called tolar, which cost 40 korunas each, about \$1.90 at 21.4 korunas to the dollar. The Here for the Beer package, put together by the Austrian Air Vacation Center, includes round-trip airfare from New York City or Washington to Prague, three nights at the Hotel U Tri Korunek, daily breakfast, a walking tour that comes with three beers and dinner, two brewery tours, a lunch at the Spilka Beer Restaurant and a three-course dinner at Pivovarsky dum. From April 1 through May 31, the package will start at \$1,269 a person, based on double occupancy (www.austrianair-vacations.com).
