Music A La Carte: Vienna Vacation Package Includes Your Choice of Three Musical Performances

Roundtrip air transportation between Washington (IAD) or New York (JFK), economy class on Austrian Airlines, private airport-hotel transfers, five (5) nights hotel accommodation in the heart of Vienna, daily buffet breakfast, and hotel taxes and service charges are all part of the package price as well. Rates start at \$3,199 for the four-star package and at \$3,699 for the five-star package for travel between November 1 - December 10, 2009 and again between January 4 - March 25, 2010, any day of the week, subject to availability - no weekend surcharge applies. During the period August 31 - October 31, 2009, rates are higher. Single supplements, upgrades, additional combinations and extensions are available upon request.

Package prices include fuel surcharges but do not include US Customs / INS / Aphis fees / International Transportation Tax / Passenger Facility Charges / Civil Aviation Security Fee / domestic and foreign Security and Airport Charges of approximately USD \$115 per passenger, depending on the itinerary. Additional taxes and fees may be collected by foreign governments. All taxes / fees / surcharges are subject to change and exchange rate fluctuations and may vary on the day of booking.
