Single supplements, upgrades, additional combinations and extensions are available upon request.

All Bohemian Rhapsody packages must be paid in full within 7 days after reservations are confirmed, and no later than 14 days prior to departure. Once confirmed, the packages are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be changed. All packages will be booked on Austrian Air in economy class and are subject to schedule and space availability. Your maximum stay in Europe is 30 days, and all travel must be completed by March 25, 2010. Package prices include fuel surcharges, but they do not include US Customs / INS / Aphis fees / International Transportation Tax / Passenger Facility Charges / Civil Aviation Security Fee / domestic and foreign Security and Airport Charges of up to approximately USD \$145 per passenger. Additional taxes and fees may be collected by foreign governments. All taxes / fees / surcharges are subject to change and exchange rate fluctuations and may vary on the day of booking.
