## Crazy for Krakow

*Austrian Airlines' City Steal Includes Air and Three Nights Hotel*

ATLANTA (July 17, 2009) - Krakow, Poland's 1,000-year-old cultural capital and one of UNESCO's World Heritage sites, continues to draw visitors from all over the world. This stunningly beautiful city, one of the few Polish cities not destroyed during World War II, easily takes visitors from the 13th century to the present - and back again.

Krakow's growing popularity as a tourist destination has prompted Austrian Airlines Vacation Center to create a number of vacation packages that feature the historic city by itself or in combination with either Warsaw (Poland) or Vienna (Austria). This winter, the Krakow City Steal (see <http://www.austrianair-vacations.com/Krakow>) starts at \$909 per person, double occupancy and includes roundtrip economy class air transportation from either New York (JFK) or Washington, DC (IAD), three nights hotel accommodation in Hotel PTTK Wyspianski (superior tourist class) in the heart of Krakow, daily buffet breakfast, hotel service charges and hotel taxes.

You can also go for a full week and combine three nights in Krakow with three nights in Warsaw @ \$1,189 per person in three-star hotels, including first class rail transportation from Krakow to Warsaw (see <http://www.austrianair-vacations.com/KrakowWarsaw>). Finally, if you prefer to visit two cities in two different countries, check out the six-night Krakow-Vienna combination (see <http://www.austrianair-vacations.com/KrakowVienna>), starting at \$1,109 per person. These packages are all valid for travel between November 1-December 10, 2009 and again from January 4-March 25, 2010 (see [www.austrianair-vacations.com](http://www.austrianair-vacations.com)), any day of the week, subject to availability - no weekend surcharge applies. Single supplements, upgrades, additional combinations and extensions are available upon request.

"Krakow is still somewhat of a mystery to many US travelers," notes Bram Majtli, president of Austrian Airlines Vacation Center. "You will find that Krakow, home to famous composers such as Chopin and Paderewski, offers culture, history and architecture around every corner - so come discover it, and then you too will be crazy for Krakow!"

All City Steals must be paid in full within 7 days after reservations are confirmed, and no later than 14 days prior to departure. Once confirmed, the packages are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be changed. All packages will be booked on Austrian Airlines in economy class and are subject to schedule and space availability. Your minimum stay is 3 nights or one Saturday overnight, and your maximum stay in Europe is 30 days. City Steals package prices include fuel surcharges but do not include US Customs / INS / Aphis fees / International Transportation Tax / Passenger Facility Charges / Civil Aviation Security Fee / domestic and foreign Security and Airport Charges of approximately USD \$145 per passenger, depending on the itinerary. Additional taxes and fees may be collected by foreign governments. All taxes / fees / surcharges are subject to change and exchange rate fluctuations and may vary on the day of booking.
