New Vacation Package Highlights Austria's Three Most Famous Cities

Austrian Airlines and Austrian Airlines Vacation Center have created a 10-day, nine-night vacation package that showcases the scenic and cultural highlights in Austria's three most famous cities.

The Awesome Austria vacation package includes three nights in Innsbruck in the heart of Austria's Alps; three nights in Salzburg, the city of Mozart (and the Sound of Music); and three nights in Austria's imperial capital, Vienna.

The package includes roundtrip air, economy class between either New York JFK or Washington Dulles to Innsbruck as well as first-class, one-way rail transportation from Innsbruck to Salzburg and from there to Vienna. The three different hotels featured in the package are all first-class, centrally located hotels known for high-quality service: Hotel Innsbruck, NH Hotel Salzburg, and Hotel Johann Strauss (in Vienna). Daily breakfast buffet, hotel service charges and hotel taxes are included.



The Schonbrunn Palace is Vienna's most-visited tourist attraction, with some 8 million visitors in 2007. It was the summer palace of Maria Theresia and the Habsburg dynasty. The palace and its gardens are not quite as extensive as Versailles, but Schonbrunn certainly is in that league for size and the sumptuousness of its decoration

The rate for the basic package from New York and Washington is \$1,699 per person, double occupancy for travel during the period November 1 to December 10 and again between January 4 and March 25, 2010. Single supplements at \$440 and extension nights in any of the three cities are available upon request. Note that November 6-9, November 27-29, December 4-7 and December 11-13 are closed-out dates for Salzburg. November 27-29, December 4-9, December 11-13, and March 5-11 are closed-out dates for Vienna. Prices will be higher if rooms are available.

Awesome Austria and all other '[City Steals' vacation packages](#) offered by Austrian Airlines Vacation Center must be paid in full within seven days after reservations are confirmed, and no later than 14 days prior to departure. Once confirmed, the packages are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be changed. All packages will be booked on Austrian Airlines in economy class and are subject to schedule and space availability. Your minimum stay is 3 nights or one Saturday overnight, and your maximum stay in Europe is 30 days.

City Steals package prices include fuel surcharges but do not include US and foreign government and airport charges of approximately \$135 per passenger, depending on the itinerary. Additional taxes and fees may be collected by foreign governments.

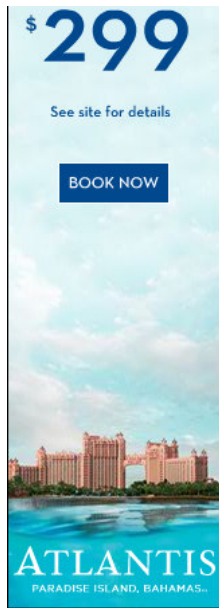
