## Well-priced Winter Vacation Packages on Austrian Airlines Start at \$799 from New York or Washington, DC

*"City Steals" to Vienna, Prague or Budapest Include Air, Three Nights Hotel*

ATLANTA (October 7, 2009) - Take advantage of some great deals to travel to Europe this winter: right now, you can secure a three-night, four-day vacation to Vienna, Prague or Budapest for just \$799, valid for travel between November 1 - December 10, 2009 and again from January 4 - March 25, 2010 (see [www.austrianair-vacations.com](http://www.austrianair-vacations.com)).

\$799 per person, double occupancy, includes roundtrip economy class air transportation from either New York (JFK) or Washington, DC (IAD), three nights hotel accommodation in the city you select (Vienna, Austria; Prague, Czech Republic; or Budapest, Hungary), daily buffet breakfast, hotel service charges and hotel taxes. Travel is valid any day of the week, subject to availability - no weekend surcharge applies. All hotels featured in these \$799 City Steals are centrally located, superior tourist class properties. "This special package price (yes, it's actually \$80 less than last year!) helps smart travelers stretch their travel dollars," notes Bram Majtli, president of Austrian Airlines Vacation Center. To upgrade a basic three-night City Steal package to a first class, four-star hotel, add \$140 per person, while the five-star deluxe version, with three nights in the InterContinental Hotel in either Vienna, Prague or Budapest, is priced at \$1,099 per person, double occupancy.

One of the advantages of any of Austrian Airlines' vacation packages is its flexibility: you may stay in Europe up to 30 days, and you can use the hotel nights at the beginning or the end of your trip, as long as you use them consecutively. Furthermore, one optional stopover in Vienna is allowed, so if you select a City Steal beyond Vienna, you may want to add some extra days in Vienna on your way to or from your final destination - though of course, additional hotel accommodations are extra. Single supplements, upgrades, additional combinations and extensions are available upon request.

All City Steals must be paid in full within 7 days after reservations are confirmed, and no later than 14 days prior to departure. Once confirmed, the packages are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be changed. All packages will be booked on Austrian Airlines in economy class and are subject to schedule and space availability. Your minimum stay is 3 nights or one Saturday overnight, and your maximum stay in Europe is 30 days. City Steals package prices include fuel surcharges but do not include US Customs / INS / Aphis fees / International Transportation Tax / Passenger Facility Charges / Civil Aviation Security Fee / domestic and foreign Security and Airport Charges of approximately USD \$145 per passenger, depending on the itinerary. Additional taxes and fees may be collected by foreign governments. All taxes / fees / surcharges are subject to change and exchange rate fluctuations and may vary on the day of booking.
