## **GAWL Installs New President, Pilar Prinz, and Board of Directors;**

On May 12, 2010, the Georgia Association for Women Lawyers (GAWL, [www.gawl.org](http://www.gawl.org)) inducted its new Board of Directors, including President **Pilar Prinz** and President-Elect **Lindsay Verity**. The ceremony, which took place as part of GAWL's Annual Dinner and Meeting, was attended by nearly 250 lawyers and judges, including Supreme Court Chief Justice Carol Hunstein.

Currently, GAWL represents and is a valuable resource for nearly 1,100 women lawyers throughout the entire State of Georgia. The Association has six Chapters in Atlanta, Columbus, Savannah, Southside Atlanta, Gwinnett County, Augusta, and at John Marshall Law School.

Pilar Prinz, who has served on GAWL's Board for the past six years, specializes in divorce law and is a named partner at the law firm of Lawler Green Givelber & Prinz. Pilar's practice consists of divorce litigation, prenuptial agreements, modification of custody and support, contempt, and legitimation actions. Pilar is a former Chairperson of the Family Law Committee of the Young Lawyers Division, and is a Barrister of the Charles Longstreet Weltner Family Law Inn of Court. She was named a Super Lawyer in 2010, Rising Star in 2005, 2007, 2009, and a member of the Georgia Trends Legal Elite in 2007 through 2009. Even though Pilar and her husband Andy Prinz, a director at Spanx, Inc., have two young daughters, Pilar has still been able to find the time to train for and complete three marathons and two Half-Ironman races.

President-Elect Lindsay Verity is the director of the Grandparent/Relative Caregiver Project at the Atlanta Legal Aid Society. In this capacity, Lindsay assists relatives with adopting or gaining custody of the children in their care and trains volunteer attorneys to handle adoption cases for relative caregivers. She also drafts advanced planning documents to plan for the care of the child in the event of the caregiver's illness or death. Prior to joining the Grandparent/Relative Caregiver Project, she specialized in providing free civil legal services to people living with HIV or cancer. Additionally, she is on the Board of Directors of the Atlanta Bar Association and is the Chair of the Public Interest Committee of the Atlanta Bar. She was chosen as one of Georgia Trend magazine's Legal Elite in 2005, 2006, and 2007 and as a Georgia Super Lawyers Rising Star in 2005, 2009, and 2010. Unlike Pilar, Lindsay abhors running and prefers to spend her free time by a pool or attempting to play softball.
