Tree-O of Love Performs at Social Resto Café Bar on August 14

ATLANTA – August 12, 2010 – On Saturday evening, August 14 from 8 – 11 PM, Tree-O of Love, one of Atlanta’s most beloved interactive jazz trios (www.justinchesarek.com), will perform at Social Resto Café Bar, the vibrant Euro-Mediterranean restaurant in the heart of downtown Atlanta (<http://socialintown.com>).

Justin Chesarek (drums), Akeem Marable (saxophone) and Craig Shaw (bass) make up Tree-O. The three talented musicians started together along with others in the Justin Chesarek Quintet at Churchill Grounds in 2008, where they wrote and performed original works such as Marable’s *Blood on the Piano!*, a piece recently featured in independent films.

As Tree-O, the group extends its favorite repertoire, techniques, and brotherhood to the audience through distinctive and memorable performances. Informed by jazz greats such as Ahmad Jamal, Thelonious Monk and Ornette Coleman, they play original compositions as well as their own arrangements of popular jazz repertoire.

“We are honored to bring Tree-O of Love to Social Resto,” says Rheda “Ray” Chikhaoui, the restaurant’s owner who shares his passion for jazz with the members of the band. “I have heard them play many times and we have become great friends. To be able to introduce Tree-O to our guests and share great music with them is just thrilling. I am sure that it will be a very special evening in downtown Atlanta!”

Social Resto, located on West Peachtree Place in the heart of downtown, is becoming known for featuring different live music acts weekly - illustrating Ray’s taste in world music, jazz and Rai. In addition, DJ Salah spins rap and hip-hop a couple of times per month. The restaurant’s cuisine highlights French, Mediterranean and North African dishes, and one of Chef Khaled Chebbi’s dishes was the August 2010 front cover of *The Atlantan*.

Social is open for lunch on Mondays through Fridays from 11 a.m. - 2:30 p.m., and Social's regular dinner hours are Mondays through Saturdays from 5:30 p.m. – 10 p.m. The restaurant is within walking distance of many downtown hotels, and is one block south of the Civic Center MARTA station.
