Spring and Summer City Steal Vacations to Vienna, Prague or Budapest: From \$1,099

Imperial City Steal Vacation Package Combines All Three Cities in One Trip

ATLANTA, February 11, 2011 - Now is the time to start making your vacation plans for Spring and Summer 2011. If you've been thinking about a trip to Europe, these flexible City Steal vacation packages from Austrian Airlines Vacation Center may just offer the right solution to finding a well-priced combination of international airfare plus hotel accommodations. Basic three-night, four-day vacations to Vienna, Prague OR Budapest start at \$1,099 per person, double occupancy, for travel between April 1 - May 13 and again between August 29 - October 29, 2011.

The \$1,099 package price (or \$1,449 per person for travel between May 14 - August 28) includes roundtrip economy class air transportation from either New York (JFK) or Washington, DC (IAD), three (3) nights hotel accommodation in (your choice) Vienna, Prague OR Budapest, daily buffet breakfast, hotel service charges and hotel taxes. Travel is valid any day of the week, subject to availability. All hotels featured in these City Steals are centrally located, superior tourist class properties, such as the Clima City Hotel in Vienna, Hotel Chopin in Prague and City Hotel Matyas in Budapest.

If you'd like to combine all three Central European cities in one vacation, consider the Imperial City Steal vacation package starting at \$1,699 per person, double occupancy. This 10-day vacation includes roundtrip air from New York or Washington, DC, economy class, plus three nights each (9 total) in Prague, Vienna and Budapest, as well as rail transportation between the three cities. During peak season, the package price is \$2,099 per person.

One of the advantages of Austrian Airlines' vacation packages is their flexibility: you may stay in Europe up to 30 days, and you can use the hotel nights at the beginning or the end of your trip, as long as you use them consecutively. Furthermore, one optional stopover in Vienna is allowed, so if you select a City Steal beyond Vienna, you can add some extra days in Vienna on your way to or from your final destination - though of course, additional hotel nights are extra. Single supplements, upgrades, additional combinations and extensions are available upon request.

All City Steals must be paid in full within 7 days after reservations are confirmed, and no later than 14 days prior to departure. Once confirmed, the packages are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be changed. All packages will be booked on Austrian Airlines in economy class and are subject to schedule and space availability. Your minimum stay is 3 nights or one Saturday overnight, and your maximum stay in Europe is 30 days. City Steals package prices include fuel surcharges but do not include US Customs / INS / Aphis fees / International Transportation Tax / Passenger Facility Charges / Civil Aviation Security Fee / domestic and foreign Security and Airport Charges of approximately USD \$160-\$220 per passenger, depending on the itinerary. Additional taxes and fees may be collected by foreign governments. All taxes / fees / surcharges are subject to change and exchange rate fluctuations and may vary on the day of booking.
