I lunched today at [Grindhouse Killer Burgers](#) on Piedmont Ave. I ran into owner Alex Brounstein who confirmed that his original location in the Sweet Auburn Curb Market is for sale. In fact, he said he has a list of prospective buyers but has yet to select one.

Once the Curb Market location is sold, he plans to begin scouting locations for a second restaurant "somewhere." He assured me that he's not tempted by the hot dog trend and will be sticking

with burgers (although the current menu does include a refreshingly pedestrian weenie). **Double Apache Burger & fries**

Brounstein also told me that **Yumbii**, the "far out food" truck, will be opening soon at Sweet Auburn Curb Market. They'll be taking the place vacated by The Greek Gyros and Pizza.

I assume that the opening of both Yumbii and **Sweet Auburn BBQ** in the market is to fulfill the city's requirement that food truck operators work out of a "brick and mortar" location.
