## Weeks Robinson Acquires Building in Cecil County Maryland

Atlanta-based Weeks Robinson has acquired a 600,000-square-foot warehouse and 32 acres of vacant land at [Trade](#) Center 95 in Cecil County Maryland near Baltimore. The transaction closed August 22 for about \$21 million.

Weeks Robinson is marketing the building to potential logistics tenants, and has already seen interest from multiple prospects, said CEO Forrest Robinson. The site can be expanded to 1.2 million square feet. Washington DC and Baltimore form one of its stronger industrial markets, Robinson said. "With very few options available to large tenants in the I-95 and Hwy. 40 corridor, this property is an excellent investment for our company and fits within our expansion plans throughout the Mid-Atlantic and Sunbelt states," Robinson said.

The Atlanta-based industrial real estate and investment firm recently raised \$150 million in [equity](#) to take advantage of opportunities within the depressed real estate market.

Earlier this year, Weeks Robinson acquired Forum 303 Crossing, a large property near the Dallas airport. Other investments include a build-to-suit distribution center in Jacksonville, Fla., which is leased for 15 years to PenserSC Logistics, and an 827,890 square foot [acquisition](#) near Dallas.

Weeks Robinson's current holdings now total more than 2.1 millions square feet.
